APPLICATION NOTES

Failure to follow these guidelines may result in the application's being returned to the applicant for revision. All applications must be computer generated. Please use the DVF Application Checklist to ensure accuracy.

Eligibility for Membership:

Any person of any age, regardless of race, religion, or ethnic background who can prove direct lineal descent from a patriot of the American Revolution who wintered at Valley Forge during the period of December 19, 1777 – June 19, 1778 is eligible for membership. Members under the age of 18 are called Junior members.

Formatting the Information:

The correct format for entering dates is: dd mmm yyy Ex: 1 Jan 1900 NOT: 1/Jan/1900 or 01/01/1900

The correct format for entering places is: city or two county state

Ex: Washington Washington Co PA NOT: Washington Washington PA

Printing the Form:

The form must be printed on one side of white 8.5" x 11" paper.

Preparing the Proof for Each Generation:

- Copies of all documentation should be clear and readable.
- Acceptable sources may include, but are not limited to, birth or baptismal records, death records, wills, probate records.
- Transcribe all handwritten proof. Submit both the transcription and the proof.
- Underline all pertinent names, facts, and dates with red pencil, indicating the appropriate generations (G1, G2, etc.) Example shown to the right.
- **Do not use staples.** If you feel you must group documents together, such as a 3-page will, use paper clips.

Preparing the Proof for Service at Valley Forge:


Proof of service at Valley Forge during the period of December 19, 1777 – June 19, 1778 must be furnished. If the patriot is on the official "Muster Roll" (http://valleyforgemusterroll.org/muster.asp) then that may be used as proof of service as long as it can be proven that the patriot on the muster roll is the patriot on the application. For example, there are two privates names Asa Smith from Massachusetts on the muster roll. It is required to prove the ancestor's correct identity. This muster roll is not comprehensive, so applicants may often prove a new patriot to join.

Using Other Lineage Society Applications as Proof:

Proven information from applications from the following lineage societies have been approved for use as proof for any generation on the application as long as acceptable proof was provided for the information on that application:

National Society Daughters of the American Revolution, National Society Sons of the American Revolution, National Society Sons of the Revolution, The Society of the Cincinnati, Jamestowne Society, General Society of Mayflower Descendants, National Society Daughters of the American Colonists, National Society Sons and Daughters of the Pilgrims, The National Society Colonial Dames XVII Century, The Colonial Dames of America, National Society Daughters of Colonial Wars, General Society of Colonial Wars
